Dear Mr. Gregozeski:

This is to advise you that the Outagamie County Agriculture, Extension Education, Zoning and Land Conservation Committee have granted your request for a conditional use permit. The permit was granted on April 10, 2018 (file number CU-11-18).

The permit will allow for the dredging, re-alignment and restoration of a navigable stream and the restoration of adjacent areas within the General Shoreland District under Section 44-8.2 of the Outagamie County Shoreland Wetland Ordinance as per plans and specifications submitted with your application.

The permit was also granted with the following conditions:

1. A certified as built plan must be provided within 30 days of completing the project.
2. Upon completion of the restoration work, the floodplain analysis shall be revised with as-constructed cross sections to compare final restoration work with what has been proposed. The analysis shall be submitted to the DNR to review for concurrence with NR 116.
3. The same conditions that are placed on the DNR permit shall become part of this approval.

Enclosed are two self-addressed post cards. One is to be mailed no later than 5 days before construction begins. The other is to be mailed no more than 10 days after construction is completed. Please contact the Zoning Administrator for a pre-construction conference.

The project area is located west of State Trunk Highway "76", east of Churchill Road and south of School Road within the Southeast ¼ and the Southwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Sections 22, Township 21 North, Range 16 East, Town of Greenville, Outagamie County, Wisconsin.
